



North Carolina District - Pilot International Scholarship Instructions General Information

GUIDELINES

1. The Scholarships shall be known as “North Carolina District Pilot International Scholarships”
2. Two scholarships shall be awarded each year and granted for one year only. The amount of the Scholarship will be determined by money raised for scholarships.
3. North Carolina local Pilot Clubs shall submit the application within ample time to reach the Committee no later than March 15 of each year.

ELIGIBILITY OF APPLICANT

1. The applicant should be screened/recommended by the sponsoring Pilot Club. We are looking for scholars who excel in ability as well as in character and commitment.
2. The applicant must be accepted to or reasonably expecting to be accepted to a four year accredited college or university in North Carolina.

APPLICATION MUST INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING ITEMS:

1. Cover letter from sponsoring Pilot Club, stating club name and name and address of local Scholarship Chair
2. Application form (preferably typed) with extracurricular activities attached
3. Description of community service activities and employment record, if applicable, may be attached
4. Applicant’s letter stating why a scholarship is needed
5. All high school transcripts
6. Three letters of recommendation, one of which must be from a high school official
