PIFF REP AMY HURST



Hello my fellow NC Pilots! What a wonderful time we had at convention!! Thank you Governor Leslie and your DAC for a great convention.

As promised at convention, Here are the bullet points of the PIFF report for NC.

- Giving Tuesday contributions totaled \$19,85.99. These funds were designated to our quarterly grants for Pick Me Ups, Helmets and the NEW BrainMinders grant.
- Since 1985, our scholarship, award and grant programs have awarded over \$2 million to clubs and individuals.
- In 2023-2024 we funded **19** Matching Grants, totaling \$**33,491.99**. Congratulation Tarboro on your matching grant!!
- Quarterly grants for the first three quarters of the Pilot year include:
 - 34 clubs received Pick Me Up Grants totaling \$6,715
 - 19 clubs received Helmet Grants totaling \$5,400
 - 5 NEW BrainMinders Grants totaling \$1,000
- June 15 is the deadline for the last quarterly grants. You can still apply!!!
- Contributions in the amount of \$8,839 honoring Club Ambassadors this year supported the Safe Harbor fund and Translation Services equally.
- March 15 was the deadline for scholarship applications, and as of March 1st, 89 applications were received.

North Carolina is recognized as a 250 District thanks to ALL of our clubs contributing \$250 to the Grants and Scholarship fund!! We also recognized 6 members as 250 donors. The President's Circle is the designation for individuals who contribute \$1,000 or more yearly. Thus far, over 20 Pilots have attained President's Circle status.

Pacesetter Clubs are those clubs that contribute \$10 per active member. These funds go to the General Fund, which allocates funds to where they are most needed. There are currently 216 Pacesetter Clubs this year, with contributions totaling \$39,585.

This year at the Denver Convention, we are adding a gift card pull! Everyone is an instant winner with prize amounts from \$10-\$100! Do you have a gift card laying around you will not use? We will take it off your hands! Send those unused gift cards to Governor Leslie and she will get them to PIHQ.

There are several PIFF fundraisers AT Denver that you can register for online or through the mail. HOWEVER, if you are not going to able to join us in Denver, you can still participate in one of the "funnest" activities of PI Convention. The Co-Pilot Calcutta is going virtual for a limited time during the month of June!! You can enter through MemberClicks and maybe win some of the cash they return to the Pilots. Let's support the Co-Pilots and make this one of the best years yet for the Bob King Memorial Scholarship fund.
